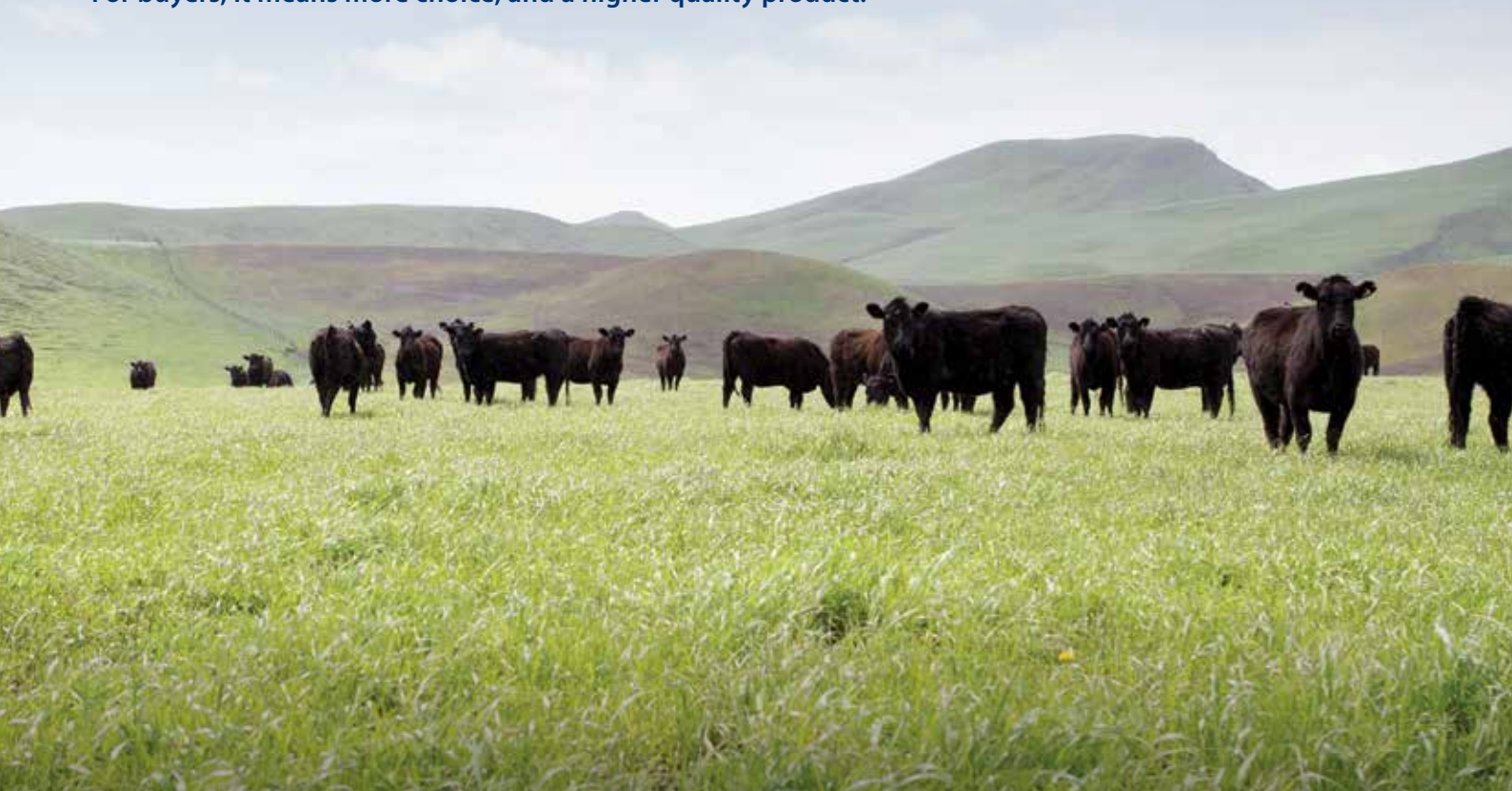

# ESTIMATED BREEDING VALUES (EBV) EXPLAINED

Estimated Breeding Values (EBVs) are the best estimate of how an animal will perform genetically as a parent.

## ACCURACY

An accuracy value is presented with every EBV and is an indication of the amount of information that has been used in the calculation of that EBV. The higher the accuracy, the lower the likelihood of change in the animal's EBV as more information is analysed for that animal or its relatives. Accuracy below 75% should be considered low, however young bulls with performance data but not all progeny will have similarly low accuracies.

## BIRTH

- 1) **BW: Birth Weight EBV (kg)** is based on the measured birth weight of animals, adjusted for dam age. The lower the value the lighter the calf at birth and the lower the likelihood of a difficult birth. This is particularly important when selecting sires for use over heifers.
- 2) **GL: Gestation Length EBV (days)** is based on AI records. Lower (negative) GL EBVs usually indicate lighter birth weights, easier calving and increased growth after birth, due to more days of growth compared to their contemporaries.

## GROWTH

- 3) **MILK: 200-day Milk EBV (kg)** is an estimate of an animal's milking ability and is derived from the weaning weight of its calf, together with information on its relatives. For sires, this EBV is indicative of their daughter's milking ability as it affects the 200 day weight of their calves.
- 4) **200: 200-day Growth EBV (kg)** is calculated from the weight of animals taken between 80 and 300 days of age. Values are adjusted to 200 days and for dam age. This EBV is the best single estimate of an animal's genetic merit for growth to weaning.
- 5) **400: 400-day Weight EBV (kg)** is calculated from the weight of animals taken between 301 and 500 days of age, adjusted to 400 days and for dam age. This EBV is the best single estimate of an animal's genetic merit for yearling weight.
- 6) **600: 600-day Weight EBV (kg)** is calculated from the weight of animals taken between 501 and 900 days of age, adjusted to 600 days and for dam age. This EBV is the best single estimate of an animal's genetic merit for growth beyond yearling age.
- 7) **MAT V: Maternal Value EBV** is an index of the EBVs for 200-day Growth and 200-day Milk, and is calculated by the following formula:  
For sires:  $MV = 1/2 \text{ Milk EBV} + 1/4 \text{ 200-day Growth EBV}$ .  
For dams:  $MV = \text{Milk EBV} + 1/2 \text{ 200-day Growth EBV}$ .

- 8) **MAT W: Mature Cow Weight EBVs** are an estimate of the genetic differences in cow weight at 5 years of age. Smaller or more moderate EBVs are generally more favourable.

## FERTILITY

- 9) **SS: Scrotal Size EBVs (cm)** are estimates of the genetic differences between bulls in scrotal circumference at 400 days of age. Increased scrotal size is associated with increased semen production and earlier age at puberty of bull and heifer progeny.
- 10) **DC: Days to Calving EBV (days)** is an indicator of female fertility based on the time between the cow's first exposure to a bull and when she subsequently calves. Cows that calve late in the season or fail to calve are penalised. Lower (negative) EBVs are preferred, indicating shorter days to calving for the sire's daughters.

## CARCASE

- 11) **RIB FAT: Rib Fat EBV (mm)** estimates the genetic differences in fat depth at the 12/13th rib in a 300 kg dressed carcass. More positive EBVs indicate more subcutaneous fat and earlier maturity.
- 12) **P8 FAT: Rump Fat EBV (mm)** estimates the genetic differences in fat depth at the P8 site of a 300kg dressed carcass. More positive EBVs indicate more subcutaneous fat and earlier maturity.
- 13) **EMA: Eye Muscle Area EBV (cm<sup>2</sup>)** estimates genetic differences in eye muscle area at the 12/13th rib site of a 300kg dressed carcass. More positive EBVs generally indicate greater muscle expression and higher retail beef yields.
- 14) **IMF %: Intra-muscular Fat Percent EBV (%)** estimates genetic differences in the percentage of intra-muscular fat in a 300kg carcass.
- 15) **RBV %: Retail Beef Yield Percent EBV (%)** estimates genetic differences in boned-out carcass yield at a 2-3mm fat trim. A more positive EBV indicates a higher boned-out carcass yield for a 300kg carcass.
- 16) **CWT: Carcass Weight EBV (kg)** estimates the genetic differences in hot standard carcass weight between animals at 650 days of age. More positive EBVs indicate heavier carcasses.

The GROUP BREEDPLAN Estimated Breeding Values contained in this Sale Catalogue were compiled by the Agricultural Business Research Institute (ABRI) from data supplied by the breeders. Neither the New Zealand Breed Associations nor the ABRI oversee or audit the collection of this data.



# SELECTION INDICES EXPLAINED

## THE BREEDOBJECT INDEX SYSTEM

Combines genetic information (EBVs) with financial information (costs and returns relating to a specific production system) and brings these together into one figure or Index (EBV for Profit), which is expressed in 'dollars per cow mated'. It has major advantages over selecting bulls using EBVs:

1. It is much more user friendly because it ranks bulls based on their profitability in a specified production system.
2. It is expressed as 'profit per cow mated', whereas most EBVs do not directly relate to profit.
3. It addresses the issues of prioritizing the economic importance of EBVs and relationships between traits, in the selection process.

Selection Indexes reflect both the short term profit generated by a sire through the sale of his progeny, and the longer term profit generated by his daughters in a self-replacing cow herd.

Standard Selection Indexes are now available for most breeds. The standard breed specific Selection Indexes have been designed to cater for the commercial market production systems of general relevance in each particular breed. These Selection Indexes are intended for use by both seedstock & commercial producers.

## SELECTION INDICES - ANGUS NZ 2018

There are currently two different selection indexes calculated for New Zealand Angus animals. These are Self-Replacing and AngusPure. Each selection index describes a different production/market scenario and relates to a typical commercial herd in New Zealand that is targeting the following specifications.

Index values are reported as EBVs, in units of relative earning capacity (\$'s) for a given market. They reflect both the short-term profit generated by a sire through the sale of his progeny, and the longer-term profit generated by his daughters in a self-replacing cow herd. More information is available on selecting animals using a selection index.

The Index values are derived using BreedObject technology. More information is available from the BreedObject web site.

**SELF-REPLACING INDEX (\$)** - Estimates genetic differences between animals in net profitability per cow joined for a self-replacing commercial herd, targeting the production of grass finished steers. Steers are assumed marketed at 525 kg live weight (280 kg carcass weight and 10 mm fat depth) at 16 months of age.

**ANGUSPURE INDEX (\$)** - Estimates genetic differences between animals in net profitability per cow joined for a self-replacing commercial Angus herd, targeting the production of grass finished steers for the AngusPure programme. Steers are assumed marketed at 525 kg live weight (280 kg carcass weight and 10 mm fat depth) at 18 months of age with a significant premium paid for marbling.

## SELECTION INDICES - NZ HEREFORDS 2018

Hereford selection indices are calculated for four market specifications, namely, Hereford Prime, Export, Dairy Maternal and Dairy Terminal. These Indices relate to typical commercial herds in New Zealand targeting these specifications.

Index values are reported as EBVs, in units of relative earning capacity (\$'s) for a given market. They reflect both the short-term profit generated by a sire through the sale of his progeny, and the longer-term profit generated by his daughters in a self-replacing cow herd (where applicable). A selection index combines the EBVs with economic information (costs and returns) for specific market and production systems to rank animals based on relative profit values. Note that different types of animals can give similar profit values, so consideration should be given to both the index and the component EBVs when selecting animals for a particular production system. More information is available on selecting animals using a selection index.

The Index values are derived using BreedObject technology. More information is available from the BreedObject web site.

**HEREFORD PRIME INDEX (\$)** - Estimates the genetic differences between animals in net profitability per cow joined for an example commercial self replacing herd where Hereford bulls are joined to either Hereford or British breed females targeting the production of grass finished steers for the Hereford Prime programme. Steers are assumed marketed at 510 kg live weight (275 kg HSCW and 10 mm fat depth) at 20 months of age. Daughters are retained for breeding.

**EXPORT INDEX (\$)** - Estimates the genetic differences between animals in net profitability per cow joined for an example commercial self replacing Hereford herd targeting the production of grass finished steers for the export trade. Steers are assumed marketed at 600 kg live weight (330 kg HSCW and 10 mm fat depth) at 20 months of age. Daughters are retained for breeding.

**DAIRY MATERNAL INDEX (\$)** - Estimates the genetic differences between animals in net profitability per cow joined for an example commercial dairy herd targeting the production of dairy beef progeny. All steers are assumed marketed at 500 kg live weight (260 kg carcass weight and 6 mm fat depth) at 20 months of age. The Hereford Dairy cross heifer progeny are particularly sought after as beef breeding cows and consequently, maternal traits are of importance.

**DAIRY TERMINAL INDEX (\$)** - Estimates the genetic differences between animals in net profitability per cow joined for an example commercial dairy herd targeting the production of dairy beef progeny, where all progeny are slaughtered. Steers are assumed marketed at 500 live weight (260 kg HSCW and 6 mm fat depth) at 18 months of age.

**NOTE:** \$Index values for individual animals are sensitive to the assumptions used in the BreedObject analysis to calculate the selection index.

## FINANCIAL IMPLICATIONS OF USING AN INDEX

Two bulls, with Indexes of \$0 and \$50 are mated to genetically similar cows. Each bull mates 200 cows during its lifetime. The second bull, with an Index of \$50, will generate \$5000 ( $\$50/2 \times 200$ ) more profit during his lifetime than the first bull.

## ORDER OF SALE

Intending purchasers and vendors are advised that unforeseen circumstances could change the order of sale and Lots may not necessarily be sold in numerical order. Any alteration to sale order will be announced prior to the sale commencing.

## START PRICE

It is a requirement of the relevant breed society that no vendor will sell a Lot on sale day below the start price notified by the respective breed society for that Lot.

## INSURANCE

Insurance is the responsibility of the purchaser from the fall of the hammer.

## PURCHASERS' REBATE

All intending purchasers must register at the sales office prior to the sale. PGW will pay a purchasing rebate of 6% of the purchase price excluding GST, plus GST, to livestock companies and recognized independent livestock agents with a PGW account who have introduced purchaser to PGW before the sale and/or accompanied purchasers to the sale.

## PICK OF THE DROP

Pick of the Drop must be selected at date mutually determined by the vendor and the purchaser, within four months of the sale day. The terms of sale for the animal selected, including fertility guarantees, are to be agreed between the respective vendor and purchaser.

## ADDITIONAL SALE TERMS

### 1. HEALTH TESTS

- 1.1 The Vendor warrants that:
- the Stock has been TB tested and cleared within 12 months of the date of the sale;
  - the Stock has been treated with Bayticol and Vetmed Flumethrin Pour-On or an equivalent approved product within 2-7 days of leaving the Vendor's Property for delivery to the grazing unit;
  - the Stock has been tested BVD Antigen negative and has been vaccinated twice within the 12 months prior to the date of sale;
  - as at the date of the National Bull Sale, neither the Stock nor any property on which it has been located has been subject to any notice or order or any other direction from Ministry for Primary Industries (or any other entity or organization appointed by Ministry for Primary Industries or empowered under the Biosecurity Act 1993 or any replacement or subordinate legislation or regulation) (MPI) issued under the Biosecurity Act 1993 or any other legislation or regulations;
  - as at the date of the National Bull Sale, the Stock is not subject to testing by MPI for any notifiable organism (as provided for by the Biosecurity Act 1993);
  - as at the date of the National Bull Sale, the Stock is fit and free from disease; and
  - as at the date of the National Bull Sale, the Stock is registered with the relevant breed society.

### 2. CARE OF ANIMAL BY PURCHASER

- 2.1 The Purchaser will throughout the 12 months following the sale:
- ensure that the Stock has proper care and attention, and is maintained in good condition and health;
  - give the Stock full and sufficient opportunity to prove that it is/they are a good server.

### 3. FERTILITY GUARANTEE

- 3.1 The Vendor warrants for a period of 12 months following the date of sale that the Stock is fertile and capable of service.
- 3.2 Except as set out in clause 3.3 below, if the Purchaser provides PGG Wrightson Limited with a veterinarian's certificate evidencing that the Stock is infertile, incapable of service or lacking a reasonable level of fertility within that 12 month period, then the Vendor will refund the purchase price of the relevant animal only in full within 28 days of receipt by PGG Wrightson Limited of the veterinarian's certificate. On refund of the purchase price, title and risk in the Stock will revert to the Vendor and the Purchaser will arrange to transport the Stock back to the Vendor, at the Purchaser's cost.
- 3.3 If the Vendor disputes the veterinarian's certificate within 10 days of the receipt of the certificate by PGG Wrightson Limited, the parties will within a further 5 days appoint an independent expert to determine whether the Stock is infertile or incapable of service, or has less than a reasonable level of fertility, at the Vendor's cost. If the parties cannot agree on an independent expert the relevant breed society will appoint an independent expert. The decision of the expert shall be accepted as final and binding by the parties and the purchase price will be refunded within 28 days

of receipt by PGG Wrightson Limited of the independent expert's opinion, if the independent expert finds that the Stock is infertile, or incapable of service, or has less than a reasonable level of fertility. The provisions in clause 3.2 above about title and risk will apply.

- 3.4 The refund of the purchase price as provided for in this clause 3 is the Purchaser's sole remedy in the case of the total infertility of the Stock or the Stock's inability to service, or less than reasonable fertility. The Vendor is not liable for any consequential or indirect losses, or any loss of profit, consequential loss or any other form of loss.

#### 4. NAIT & TRANSFER

- 4.1 The Vendor will arrange the transfer of the Stock and pay the fee for transfer in accordance with the respective breed society rules.
- 4.2 The Vendor will procure that the relevant breeding unit complies with the National Animal Identification and Tracing Act 2012 in respect of the transfer of the Stock to the Purchaser.






